Army inaugurates rehabilitation project at Uri

Srinagar, April 11, (Scoop News)- In a unique gesture of support, the Army has rebuilt three houses destroyed in a terrorist attack at Kalgai village of Uri Tehsil in Baramulla district. An inauguration ceremony of Uri Rehabilitation Project was organised by the Army at Kalgai village in frontier town of Uri in Northern Kashmir's Baramulla District on 11 Apr 2018.

The aim of this project was to rehabilitate the crippling lives of three families residing in Kalgai village which got completely destroyed in the suicide terrorist attack on a military camp on 23 Sep 2017 in which four foreign terrorists were eliminated. All the neighbouring border villagers, Numberdar and Sarapnch attended this ceremony.
